- Official police numbers highlight the fact that cops are most likely to stop and frisk dark-skinned than white in Europe.

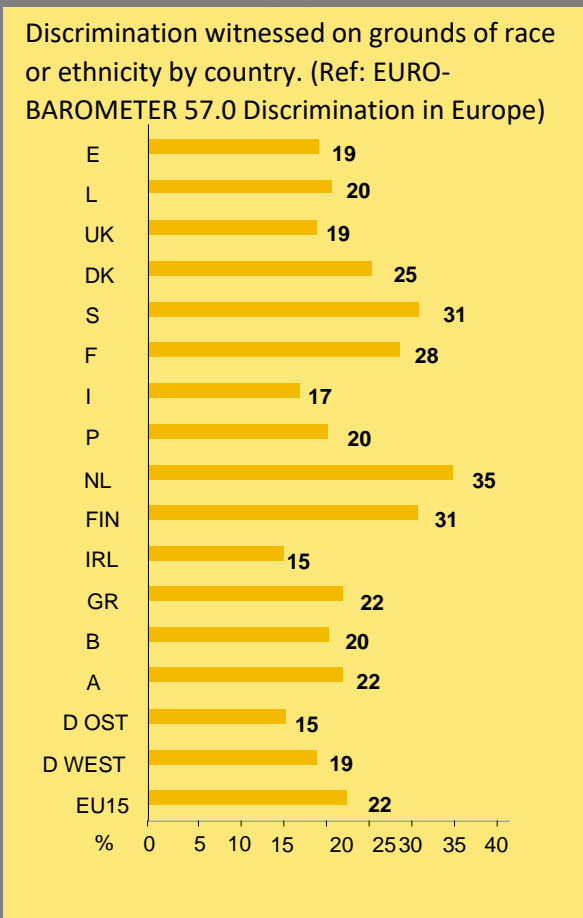
Combating Discrimination:

- Monitoring the situation

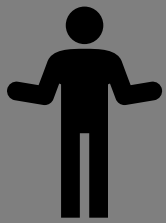
